THE PROGRAM AND STANDARDS:

- The full Ministry of Education curriculum is taught at Maranatha, geared to each child's grade level, plus extra-curricular subjects (such as Bible Teaching, Drama, Arts and Music).
 - All ages meet together in one room, much like the traditional schoolhouse setting.
 - School runs three days per week (Tues, Wed, Thurs). Child is required to attend all three days per week, for consistency and most positive learning experience.
 - All subjects taught are faith-based, and every day includes Assembly Time with prayer and the National Anthem sung.
 - A fee of \$145/week/child is payable every Friday by 5PM for the next week's service, paid in cash or by e-transfer.
 - After-School Program is offered 3PM-4:30PM for an added cost of \$10/day, paid along with weekly fees.

By signing below, the applicant acknowledges that this is the final step in the approval process. If the Administrator has confirmed approval of application by email. Along with this completed Registration Form, in order to solidify your child's space, all initial payments indicated below must be received. The signing applicant is in agreement with everything stated on this Registration Form as well as all details covered in the School Prospectus (most current version is posted on website) and the Rules of Conduct (attached). Admission to this tutoring program is on a first- come basis, so expediency in completing the application process is recommended. An initial fee payment of **\$245** per child is required to complete this application process. This initial payment includes \$145 non-refundable deposit which is applied to the child's last week at Maranatha Schoolhouse, plus \$100 toward the initial cost of the child's school curriculum. Additional curriculum costs may be required later in the school year, but will not exceed \$200 annually.

Statement of Consent

I hereby recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants during Maranatha Schoolhouse activities, and I voluntarily agree to assume the risk of any and all injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that my child/ward or I may sustain as a result of participating in any activities connected with the Maranatha Schoolhouse. I further agree to waive all claims towards its Administrator, Educators, Directors or Pastor, as well as any volunteer or ministry member, in the result of any accident that occurs during the program. 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RULES OF CONDUCT

Making the daily program and its activities enjoyable and a very positive experience for all children is a priority at Maranatha Schoolhouse. To ensure this, we uphold the following rules, which we ask that you review with your child before they start attending Maranatha Schoolhouse during the school year or summer.

1. Parent/Guardian must sign each child in/out and print clearly when filling in the information. Child is not to enter the school until a staff member or volunteer greets him/her at the door and acknowledges the sign-in has been completed. Likewise, when picking up your child, sign them out at the entrance and ensure a staff member or volunteer acknowledges the departure.
2. We encourage the children to invite friends to attend Maranatha Schoolhouse programs, provided space availability. Their friend may come once without needing to register, to check out the program, but prior to the next visit, all admission forms and procedures will need to be completed by their parent/guardian.
3. Should any child become unruly, unmanageable or using foul inappropriate language at either of the programs, the parent will be contacted and asked to come for pick-up immediately. Standard discipline measures are in place, and the children will be fully aware of those measures and expectations, but when violated, the School Administrator or Educator has the authority to instill the following discipline measures: 1) At first offense, the child will be spoken with and questions asked of his/her perspective of what just happened; 2) Repeat offense will warrant isolation from the other children, within Educator or Administrator's view, giving time to reflect on and consider proper response to such circumstances in the future; 3) Before being invited back to the group, a discussion will take place privately between the child and Educator or Administrator, and any necessary apologies made; 4) If the incident warrants it, the Educator or Administrator may mention this to the parent at pick up time. If such incidents happen repeatedly and frequently, a conversation will be had with the parents.
4. Bullying is not tolerated, in effort to keep all children safe and to maintain a positive spirit of camaraderie and Christian love between all children. When conflict arises, the school will always give ear to both sides so that each individual may defend their position, but should a child repeatedly exhibit bullying tendencies, the parents will be spoken with, and a plan on how to deal with it will be determined between the school and the parents.
5. Personal electronic devices are not permitted during school hours, so please keep all such items in the car or at home. We also discourage the bringing of any personal toys or other items, to avoid damage or loss. However, the school may allow for special items to be shared at specific occasions, for which a note will be sent home well in advance.
6. There is zero tolerance at Maranatha Schoolhouse for children's use of alcohol, drugs, cigarettes, vape smoking or any other harmful substance while attending the program. Such behaviour will warrant immediate expulsion from the program.
7. While there is no uniform at Maranatha Schoolhouse, the children are required to dress modestly at all times in order to prevent such distractions, even during hot summer days. Modestly constitutes of inseam shorts at least 3", pant waistline not worn below naval area, no belly tops, girls' skirts are to be worn with shorts underneath, and girls' neckline not revealing. Repeat violation will require child being sent home to change.
8. Maranatha Schoolhouse operates on the Golden Rule of "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you." - showing respect at all times to every child and adult.
